St.John's Church Building Redecoration.

The church building was constructed around 1904 on land provided by William Lowndes. This type of building is known as a 'tin tabernacle' – they were 'off the shelf' buildings and were very popular in the late 19th century. Many have been lost or had a change of use so St John's is now one of a limited number of churches. As you will have seen it is in



need of a coat of paint on the zinc sheet and the wood work. We're hoping this work will start in the early summer so watch out for developments!
